WHAT BOSTON SMALL BUSINESSES NEED TO KNOW AHEAD OF THE FIFA WORLD CUP 26™

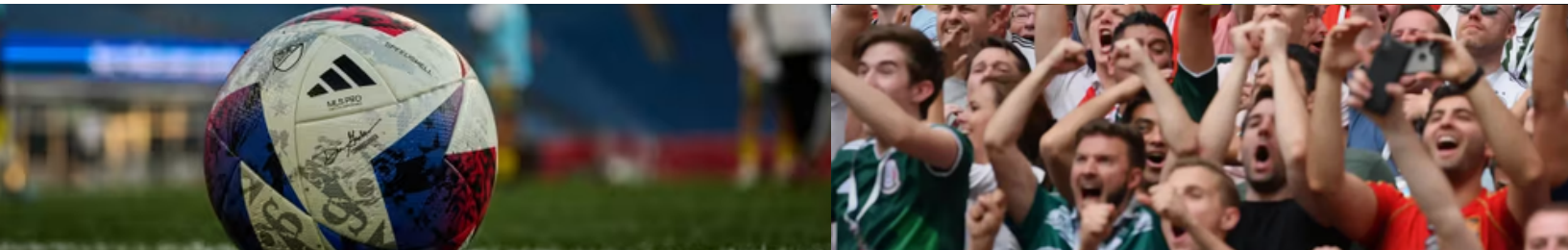
FIFA World Cup 26™ will take place from **June 13 to July 9**. Seven of the matches will take place at Gillette Stadium (renamed Boston Stadium during the tournament) on **June 13, June 16, June 19, June 23, June 26, June 29, and July 9**.

During this event, Boston will welcome international tourists and see increased economic activity. Read on for guidelines and resources.



THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW LEADING UP TO THE FIFA WORLD CUP 26™

- Ensure servers and bartenders are up to date on **alcohol certification**. Email [here](#) to schedule an in-person class today.
- **Review staffing for event days**. Stay flexible, cross-train staff, and schedule for peak times.
- **Plan ahead for transportation and parking**. Adjust deliveries if needed and identify alternate routes for staff.
- If your business typically shows **sporting events on televisions**, you CAN show any or all matches WITHOUT a FIFA Public Viewing License. There are regulations related to marketing and ticketing. [View the regulations](#).
- You have the ability to **optimize business hours** during key matches by opening earlier or requesting an extension of hours. [View the procedure](#).
